

If some of the powder be heated in a small test-tube, it will be sublimed, and small octahedral crystals, visible to the naked eye, or by lens, settle on the sides of the test-tube. 3. If arsenous acid be mixed with freshly burnt powdered charcoal, and heated in a small test-tube, a ring of shining metallic arsenic of a gray color will be found on the cool portion of the tube, and an odor of garlic is perceptible.
